English Clubs Pilot

Earlier this week, the Education Team's Innovation and Logistics Officers piloted the first session of the English Club for approximately 40 standard 5 and 6 students at Mlimani Primary School.

This initial session focused on a "beach" theme, with corresponding games and interactive activities meant to teach students beach-based vocabulary.

Students seemed excited to participate and engaged throughout the session, with both students and teachers requesting that we continue executing the clubs moving forward.

As of now, our plan is to spend our remaining time this summer developing an initial English Club curriculum, so that next summer, CDI and KITE volunteers can roll out a full English Club program at Mlimani Primary School.

The program could be rolled-out at other primary schools in the Ubungu District of Dar Es Salaam as well in 2019.
